

TUTORIAL FOR GAMES MAINTENANCE

Version 3

This is a tutorial to explain how to use the system to maintain the score of a match.

Please follow the steps.

NOTE: You must be a registered user and have “Recorder” access rights, to be able to access the “Games maintenance” screen. If you are not registered yet, please go to the website www.ttaustralia.net and register yourself and request the access rights as a “Recorder”.

These are the steps to record a match.

- 1) First, login into the system;
- 2) Go to menu “Games maintenance” under “Teams” menu as per image below.

Then follow the steps in the order below:

1. Select the competition;
2. Select the division;
3. Select the week;
4. Select the match you want to edit the score;

After you select the match, you can click on the button "Edit", for each game as the arrow is pointing in the image below.

The screen is pretty much as "Match points" screen, but a bit more simplified for this purpose.

All the rules are the same, and if any issue happens you will be prompted with a message highlighted in red on the top of the screen.

Finishing

Note: If you select a match that has already been submitted to Ratings Central, you will not be able to edit any game as shown in the image below.
